A total of 419 votes have been cast on 02 July 2021 through Civica Election Services (CES). The report of voting provided by CES is attached. The voting process was entirely anonymous, and the only information held by the EASD office in Düsseldorf is this single report from CES attached here.

By using the single transferable vote electoral system, you adopted the motion concerning the election of Prof Allan Flyvbjerg with 126 valid votes and Prof Ruth Loos with 122 valid votes.

Prof Flyvbjerg and Prof Loos will then become full members of the Board of our Association with a term of office from 01 January 2022 until 31 December 2025.
